POLICIES & PROCEDURES

CLASS COST:

Unless otherwise noted, all classes are \$45 per session. Checks are made payable to GDRSD. In some cases, there are material fees that are paid directly to the instructor at the first class. Scholarships are available for children with financial need, please contact Karen Tuomi or Peter Myerson.

CLASS LOCATIONS:

The campus location is identified with each class. Participants will receive confirmation of acceptance along with classroom assignment via e-mail. The students attending the school site will have first choice for classes; however, if a class remains open, any student can attend. NOTE: There is at least one bus from Swallow Union that goes to Florence Roche.

REGISTRATION:
