POLICIES & PROCEDURES

CLASS COST:

Unless otherwise noted, all classes are \$45 per session. Checks are made payable to GDRSD. In some cases, there are material fees that are paid directly to the instructor at the first class. Scholarships are available for children with financial need; please contact Karen Tuomi or Peter Myerson.

CLASS LOCATIONS:

The campus location is identified with each class. Participants will receive confirmation of acceptance along with classroom assignment via e-mail. The students attending the school site will have first choice for classes; however, if a class remains open, any student can attend. NOTE: There is at least one bus from Swallow Union that goes to Florence Roche.

REGISTRATION:

Registrations are accepted January 6 through January 21. **NO REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED AFTER JANUARY 21ST.** To register for a class, please fill out the attached form, enclose a check payable to GDRSD and return both to the school office or mail to GDRSD Community Ed, PO Box 426, Groton, MA 01450. 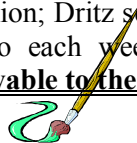
BEGINNERS SEWING

Required supplies, available at Joanne Fabrics, are: package of (12) DMC embroidery needles, size 1-5 SKU#077540382552 \$1.39; ball point dressmaker pins (colored), size 17-1^{1/16} SKU#072879104523 \$3.29; seam ripper by Dritz \$1.69; 60” tape measure; pin cushion; Dritz sewing gauge \$1.99; and pair of scissors with pointed tip; container to put all supplies and projects into each week.
