



Washington D. C. Trip Scrap Book Project:

You are going to make a scrapbook of your visit to Washington D. C. When you travel, a scrapbook can be a great memento for you to enjoy with your friends and families for years to come. Your scrapbook will include pages dedicated to each of the subjects that you have studied during your time in middle school. You can also include additional pages that are just dedicated to your favorite memories of your trip to Washington D. C. Each scrapbook page should include pictures and / or postcards, captions and explanations, and other items that will help someone understand what you did in Washington and why it was important.

➤ **Here are guidelines for the content of your scrapbook:**

- Use postcards, maps and pictures from free brochures.
- You can use entire brochures and also your own notes about sayings, quotes or phrases from public places, monuments or memorials.
- Where it is allowed, you can use photographs of your own including photographs of yourself and your friends.
- Each image or other item should have a caption.
- Remember that you cannot, under any circumstances, publish photographs or other media from this event on a web page, Internet site, or in any other way.

➤ **For each of your middle school subject areas, here are the required numbers of pages:**

- Every set of pages should include a written description of what you have included, why it is important to you, and why it is important to that subject area.
- 2 pages for U. S. History or other Social Studies classes from your middle school experience.
- 2 pages to highlight things related to your studies in Science.
- 2 pages will include connections to Mathematics.
- 2 pages should be dedicated to connections to topics that you have studied in Language Arts classes.
- 1 page should be dedicated to each of the subjects that you have studied in Integrated Arts. You will want to dedicate a page to **Physical Education, Wellness, Drama, Public Speaking, the Foreign Language** that you study, **Art, and Music, Chorus, or Band.**
- You are welcome to dedicate pages to connections to school and community activities that you have been involved in during your years in middle school.

Remember, this scrapbook is for you to demonstrate your learning in each of your subjects. It is also for you to enjoy as a memory book of your trip to Washington D. C. **In order to give you time to complete your scrapbook project, we have set Monday, June 23 as the due date for this assignment.**
